Dear Parent/Carer Salam alaykum,

As we reach the end of term I would like to pass on some information regarding the end of term and September. We will be closing for the Summer holidays on Friday 16th July at 1.10pm. The school bus service will arrive at 1.10 to take students home. If your daughter does not use the Academy's bus service, then please arrange for her to be collected at 1.10pm.

September Start for Pupils

As we are using the first two days of term for testing we will be operating a staggered start from Monday 6th September. Testing will take place on Thursday 2nd and Friday 3rd September. Please see letter sent out last week for further details.

From Monday 6th September your daughter will need to be in full uniform and come fully prepared for lessons. Once your daughter starts school as below she will then continue to attend as normal. Your daughter will need to return to school for **her first day** in September as follows:

Please note: the school bus **will not** be running on the morning of the 6th September. Years 7, 12 and 11 will need to make their own way to school for their designated time of arrival. The bus service will be running on Monday afternoon to take students home. Then from Tuesday 7th September school bus service will be available as normal. If you have any further queries, please do not hesitate to contact your daughter's Student Service Officer.

Attendance and Punctuality

The Academy expects a high standard of attendance and punctuality from all its students, and we regularly monitor each pupil's record. We expect attendance as close to 100% as possible.

We expect parents to:

- Inform the school by 8.20am **on the first morning** of any absence, indicating the cause and likely duration of the absence.
- Notify the school, **in writing**, when an absence ends, stating the dates and cause of the absence.
- Make every attempt to arrange dental appointments, medical appointments and holidays outside of school hours/terms.
- Lessons begin at 8.30am; we expect our students to be in the Academy for 8.20am. Please note that after-school detentions will be issued for persistent lateness (twice in one week).

Uniform

Please ensure that your daughter has the correct uniform for the beginning of the new term. In order to remind you, the criteria for uniform is as follows:

Main Uniform Option 1
Grey blazer (with green piping) - badged with school logo
Plain white blouse – to be worn under the school blazer
Grey jumper (with green piping) (<i>Optional</i>) – to be worn under the school blazer
Grey skirt (ankle length)
Plain Grey headscarf with school logo (Years 7-11 only)
Plain black leggings to be worn under skirt
Plain black socks (<i>Must be worn at all times</i>)
Plain black shoes (<i>No trainers, fashion decorations, ankle boots, sling-backs, boots, suede shoes, patent leather shoes, fabric shoes or shoes with open toes. Laces and stitching must be black. Winter boots may be worn to and from school during adverse weather but not inside the building.</i>)
Plain black bag
Plain black or navy outdoor coat (<i>denim or leather jackets, or those with slogans or logos, are not permitted</i>)
Main Uniform Option 2
Plain Grey Jilbaab – badged with school logo
Grey blazer (with green piping) - badged with school logo
Plain Grey headscarf with school logo (Years 7-11 only)
Plain black leggings to be worn under Jilbaab
Plain black socks (<i>Must be worn at all times</i>)
Plain black shoes (<i>No trainers, fashion decorations, ankle boots, sling-backs, boots, suede shoes, patent leather shoes, fabric shoes or shoes with open toes. Laces and stitching must be black. Winter boots may be worn to and from school during adverse weather but not inside the building.</i>)

May I also remind you that:

- The Hijab is part of the school uniform and must be worn correctly.
- Leggings under the Jilbaab should be plain and black in colour.
- Black socks should be worn – these should be full length and cover the ankles.
- Jewellery should not be worn – prohibited items will be confiscated.
- Make-up (including Surma) is not allowed.
- Plain black shoes (not boots) must be worn.
